

## Chargeable extras

At St Marks C of E Academy, we are committed to providing high-quality early years education that is accessible, transparent, and fully compliant with government funding requirements. All three- and four-year-olds, and eligible two-year-olds, are entitled to a funded early years place, and no charges are made for the provision of this education. Any fees listed below relate only to optional additional hours, meals, or voluntary services that fall outside the funded entitlements, and these are clearly itemised to support families in understanding their choices. Our aim is to ensure parents are fully informed and able to access the provision that best meets their child's needs.
